End-of-year Contributions Donors must deliver checks on or by December 31, to claim a charitable contribution deduction for 2019. Checks that are placed in the church offering during the first worship service in 2020 will not qualify for a charitable contribution deduction in the previous year, even if the check is predated to 2019 or was written in 2019. However, checks that are written, mailed, and postmarked in 2019 will be deductible, even if they are not received by the church until 2020.
