- Tom Haslett reported on the <u>UUSG FY 2022-2023 Financial Summary</u>. Overall, our Net Increase in Reserves for 22-23 was \$29,642.00.

- Congregational Meeting for September 10th to amend the By-Laws. A notice to the congregation will be sent no later than August 13th to call a special meeting to propose changing the required number of board members from nine to seven. This would go into effect FY 24-25 if passed.
