By our Call and this formal Act of Installation, we say to you and to all the world: We have entered freely and gladly into this ministry with you, and we commit ourselves to our ministry together.

The Rev. Scot Hull:

I, too, have entered freely and gladly into this ministry with you. I have accepted your Call and our Covenant. I come here with joy, enthusiasm, and great gratitude for the gifts we bring to each other – our histories, our values, our differences, and our unities. I commit myself to journey with you in the nurturing of spirit, the unfolding of truth and meaning, the blessing of service, and the deepening of community.
